Is Vodacom DRC ready for 5G?

Khalil Al Ameriani, CEO of Vodacom DRC, has announced the company is currently conducting 5G tests in the country. The trial is being carried out under the supervision of the DRC telecom regulatory authority, ARPTC. These tests aim to ensure the telecom operator's readiness for deploying ultra-high-speed internet in the DRC.

Is the Democratic Republic of the Congo lagging behind in telecommunications?

Compared to the United States, the Democratic Republic of the Congo is massively lagging behind in the development of telecommunications. Under the country code +243, there were a total of 49.86 million connections in 2023. Among them were 49.80 million mobile phones, which corresponds to an average of 0.49 per person.

How many people in the Congo have broadband?

Values above 100 percent mean that, on average, every inhabitant has more than one connection. The Democratic Republic of the Congo is lagging behind in the expansion of broadband internet connections. Around 31 percent of all residents have access to the internet.

How fast is broadband Internet in Congo?

Back to overview: Congo (Dem. Republic) With an average download speed of 35.30 Mbit/second for fixed-network broadband internet, the Democratic Republic of the Congo ranks 119th in an international comparison. The upload rate of only 9.9 Mbit/second was significantly lower (137th place).
